The scholarship funds will be disbursed to the student after s/he successfully completes a pre-approved course of study at an accredited institution. **The scholarship amount is \$1500.**

Tirelessly working towards her undergraduate degree while simultaneously teaching Russian language drills and working for Villanova University Dining Services, Olga Foltz's life exemplified Villanova's commitment to academic excellence and personal achievement. The scholarship established in her name aspires to foster the promotion of these same values as it aids a worthy student dedicated to the study of Russian language and culture.

Applicants must supply the information required below and submit it to Dr. Mark Schrad (Mark.Schrad@villanova.edu, Political Science Department), Director of Russian Area Studies, by **March 1**. The awardee will be notified by the following **April 1** within this same spring semester.

- A Personal Statement that describes why the student intends to enroll in a Russian language immersion program.
- A list of the programs to which the student is applying.
- A current transcript.
- One letter of recommendation from a professor.
